Impacts of the Release?

XRN4576: will introduce a new read screen into the DES Portal which will enable Shippers to view corresponding read history/details as well as missing Transfer reads and additional detail such as read reason and timestamps within their portfolio view.

As a result of this change there will be no impact to existing setup or Web services.

XRN4612: This relates to Defect 655. Since Project Nexus implementation, Xoserve has had a workaround in place to ensure that missing reading data is provided to individual Shippers via email. This change is being delivered to ensure that Xoserve meets its obligations to notify both outgoing and incoming Shippers of the closing and opening reads via the .URN (Read Notification) file. Delivery of this change will see this workaround cease, and activity to return to the expected performance.
