## A3: Proposer Requirements / Final (redlined) Change

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Problem Statement:	The PAFA service contract is due for renewal with effect from 5 <sup>th</sup> July 2024 and the Performance Assurance Committee (PAC) have requested that Xoserve perform a re-procurement exercise to appoint a suitable provider and ensure continuation of service. The service to be procured is to be in line with the requirements set out within Modification 0674 which fall outside of the scope of the PAFA investment agreed for Business Plan year 24.		
	Modification 0674 Performance Assurance Techniques and Controls was initiated in order to identify any weaknesses and limitations in the performance assurance regime that were affecting the effectiveness of the performance assurance model.		
	Through this Modification 0674 it was identified that the PAFA needed to provide additional services and support within their role to the PAC.		
	To deliver these additional services and requirements, two solutions were proposed:  • The costs to be charged on a time and material basis.  • Retendering the contract to include the additional services and requirements resulting in a 'fixed' cost.		
	It was agreed in an extraordinary PAC meeting on 24 <sup>th</sup> July 2023 to not extend the PAFA contract for the final year extension (July 24 – June 25). It was decided the Central Data Service Provider (CDSP) be instructed to retender the contract and this retendering process should incorporate the additional services and requirements outlined in Modification 0674.		
Change Description:	Change to Scope It has been agreed by the PAC that the CDSP become responsible for the secure platform which the PAFA utilise to store and share information relating to industry settlement performance. As such, this transfer of responsibility from the PAFA to the CDSP has reduced the scope of the PAFA service contract. The major benefit of this is the mitigation of the impact to industry stakeholders that a change to the platform may cause e.g. onboarding and training.		
	On the 14 <sup>th</sup> November 2023, the PAC approved updates to the Performance Assurance Framework Document (PAFD) to be included within the procurement for the 2024 PAFA service contract. The additional scope includes:  • Application of Performance Assurance Techniques (PATs) • Issue Requests for Information (RFIs) to industry parties in relation to areas of Gas Settlement risk and performance. • Ensuring that responses from industry parties are collated and presented to the PAC • Represent the PAC at industry meetings (where the topic being
