Problem Statement:	Currently the UIG Additional National Data report does not provide a breakdown of energy by EUC Sub Band, which were introduced as part of Modification UNC 0644 and delivered under XRN4665 'Creation of New End User Categories'. The absence of this breakdown means that customers are not able to validate UIG allocations as effectively as is required, due to the aggregate nature at which the data is currently presented.
